

# The Communication House

**Instructions.** Seat at least 5+ people in row, facing the back of the person in front of them. The back person will be shown, only once, this drawing of a house. (No one is allowed to talk and they can only draw it once.) The back person then draws, with their finger, the house on the back of the person in front of them. That person then draws what he/she thinks has been drawn on them on the back of the person in front of them; and so on and so on. When it reaches the last person, they draw what they think's been drawn on them, on a piece of paper. When finished compare the drawing with the picture of the house and show the group. Then process by asking the group questions (see Low Ropes Essentials), driving them to the following points:

**Processing the element:**

- When communication is limited the outcome could be greatly affected.
- If each person was able to face each other, or even talk, the results would have been better.
- When we limit our communication we weaken our chances for success.
